**ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF APPLICATION**

The Application filed by Chaplin Restaurant DC, LLC, t/a Chaplin (Applicant), for renewal of its Retailer's Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on May 9, 2016, and a Protest Status Hearing on June 29, 2016, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On June 29, 2016, the Board dismissed the Application, because the Applicant failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing. *See* Board Order 2016-421.

On July 1, 2016, the Applicant filed a request for reinstatement. The Applicant explained that his representative mistakenly believed that the Protest Status Hearing was on July 29, 2016. He learned that they missed the hearing the following day.

Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Application, the Board finds that the Applicant's request constitutes good cause to reinstate the Application pursuant to 23 DCMR 1602.3.

### **ORDER**

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 20th day of July, 2016, **REINSTATE** the Application filed by Chaplin Restaurant DC, LLC, t/a Chaplin, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CR License. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant, ANC 6E, and CSNA.





Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
