ORDER DENYING APPLICANT'S REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by 2718 Corporation, t/a Chuck & Bill Bison Lounge, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CT License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on December 9, 2013, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On December 9, 2013, the Board dismissed the Application, because the Applicant failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. *See* Board Order No. 2013-603.

On December 9, 2013, Charles Gary, on behalf of the Applicant, submitted a Request for Reinstatement indicating that he failed to attend the Roll Call Hearing due to the inclement weather. The hearing concluded prior to the Applicant's appearance.

Based upon the above, the Board finds that the Applicant's explanation regarding the inclement weather does not constitute good cause under which the Board can grant reinstatement pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1602.3.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any Party adversely affected by this Order may file a Motion for Reconsideration within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b).
