**ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE**


The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Gold Star, Inc., t/a Clover Market, (Respondent), located at 5014 Connecticut Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C., has failed to pay the third year license fees for its License No. ABRA-074723 a Retailer's Class B License. Specifically, the Respondent failed to make the third year payment for its license by September 30, 2013, the deadline for all Retailer's B licenses, despite being notified of the payment date.

On October 23, 2013, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against Gold Star, Inc., t/a Clover Market, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to renew its Retailer's Class B License. ABRA's Enforcement Division confirmed that the Respondent is out of business.

It is hereby **ORDERED** on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2013, that Gold Star, Inc.'s License No. ABRA-074723 is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent.
