1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case on
3 our calendar is Case No. 16-PRO-00003, Craft Beer
4 Cellar DC, License No. 100882. Will the parties
5 please approach and identify yourself?

6 MR. KLINE: Good morning. Andrew Kline
7 on behalf of the applicant.

8 MS. GOEDRICH: Erika Goedrich, the owner.

9 MR. ECKENWILER: Mark Eckenwiler for ANC
10 6C.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are there any
12 preliminary matters?

13 MR. KLINE: There are not.

14 MR. ECKENWILER: No, sir.

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. This
16 case is scheduled for a protest hearing then, on
17 March 16th, at 1:30. And just want to let
18 everybody know that -- and since [garbled speech]
19 there are no service issues. Is that correct?
20 The [garbled speech] was provided on -- status at
21 the roll call.

22 MR. ECKENWILER: I'm not sure I follow

1 you, Mr. Chairman.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: [Speaking off
3 microphone.] All right. All right.

4 Now that the matter is scheduled for
5 hearing there are a few things that I would like
6 to remind folks, the applicant and protester --
7 the protest hearing. They should be focused on
8 the issues, only those issues that are in -- that
9 are -- only those issues that are being
10 protested. The Board does not intend to hear
11 testimony on matters that are not relevant to the
12 case. You should receive, by electronic or
13 regular mail, a letter explaining the protest
14 process, a copy of the protest information form,
15 a copy of the exhibit form. If you do not have
16 these documents please contact our Assistant
17 General counsel, Ms. Randall, following the
18 hearing.

19 It is imperative that you follow the
20 rules closely and that they are [garbled speech]
21 the protest hearing.

22 You're also required to complete and

1 submit the protest information form and the
2 exhibit form seven days before the hearing.
3 These two forms and accompanying documents need
4 to be submitted to ABRA's legal division and all
5 opposing parties in this matter. If we do not
6 receive a copy, if we do not receive -- if we do
7 not receive a copy of your protest information
8 form, your application, or your protest may be
9 subject to dismissal. Likewise, if we do not
10 receive a copy of the exhibit form and the
11 exhibits themselves your exhibits may be excluded
12 from the record. Upon a finding that the
13 opposing party has been prejudiced, or no good
14 cause for the failure to submit these forms.

15 Likewise, witnesses other than the party
16 may be subject to exclusion if not identified in
17 the protest information form. Accordingly, these
18 forms are very important. They greatly assist
19 the Board in narrowing the protest issues
20 facility and the process in keeping the parties
21 on point during the hearing. They likewise
22 provide notice to opposing parties, enabling them

1 to better prepare for the hearing.

2 We thank you for your cooperation. If
3 you have any questions, again, you can call Ms.
4 Randall at 202-442-4353 and she'll provide you
5 any information. I wish you good luck in your
6 continued negotiation if that occurs. If not,
7 we'll see you on the protest hearing on March 6th
8 at 1:30.
