ORDER AMENDING BOARD ORDER NO. 2015-046


On February 4, 2015, by Board Order No. 2015-046, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) approved the Amendment to Settlement Agreement, dated January 11, 2015, entered between SJ Enterprises, LLC, t/a The Cusbah, and ANC 6A to govern the operations of the Applicant's establishment.


The Board now seeks to amend Board Order No. 2015-046 to make clear that its official records reflect that the Application filed by the Applicant, for renewal of its Retailer's Class B License, is granted, and the Protest filed by ANC 6A in this matter was withdrawn. All other conditions adopted by Board Order No. 2015-046 shall remain in full force and effect.


Accordingly, it is this 18th day of February, 2015, **ORDERED** that:

1. 3. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant and ANC 6A.







Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
