ORDER DENYING THE APPLICANT'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

The Application for a new Retailer's CN License filed by Decades, LLC, t/a Decades (Applicant), having been protested came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing (Hearing) on September 19, 2016. The Board dismissed the Applicant's application due to its failing to attend the Hearing, personally or by a representative. *In the Matter of Decades, LLC, t/a Decades*, Case No. 16-PRO-00091, Board Order No. 2016-534 (D.C.A.B.C.B. September 28, 2016).

On September 26, 2016, the Applicant filed a Request for Reinstatement of the License Application (Request for Reinstatement). *ABRA Protest File, Case No. 16-PRO-00091*. The Board denied the Applicant's Request for Reinstatement. *In the Matter of*

Decades, LLC, t/a Decades, Case No. 16-PRO-00091, Board Order No. 2016-542 (D.C.A.B.C.B. September 28, 2016).

The Applicant now comes before the Board on a Motion for Reconsideration of the Denial of the Request for Reinstatement of the License Renewal Application (Motion for Reconsideration). *ABRA Protest File, Case No. 16-PRO-00091*.

After duly considering the motion, and for the reasons enunciated in Board Order No. 2016-542 (September 28, 2016), the Board denies the Applicant's Motion for Reconsideration.

Accordingly, it is this 19th day of October 2016, **ORDERED** that:

1. The above-referenced Motion for Reconsideration of the Denial of the License Renewal Application is **DENIED**;
2. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant, ANC 2B, and Carl W. Nelson on behalf of the Group of Five or More Protestants.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
