OFFER IN COMPROMISE¹

- Other: Dismissal of Charge I, Dismissal of Case No. 12565, conditions as specified below; submission of revised Security Plan and corporate documents clarifying ownership, fine includes case No 12-CMP-00026.

This offer in compromise will be presented to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board by the Assistant Attorney General at the summary suspension proceeding. Please be advised that this is a proposed compromise. Accordingly, it is the discretion of the Board to accept or reject this offer.

In addition to the suspension above, the offer in compromise consists of the following terms:


- (1) Submission of the July 21, 2011 revised operating agreement.
- (2) Submission to the Board within 14 days of a revised security plan, which will address:
 - a. Installation, operation, and recording of video cameras throughout the establishment covering all blind spots, entrances, exits, service areas, hallways, dance floors, and the mezzanine. The camera video tapes must be maintained for no less than 30 days. Video must be available immediately upon request of ABRA or MPD.
 - b. Employment of MPD reimbursable detail, with a minimum of four officers, on Friday and Saturday nights.
 - c. Increase in security staff to ensure that between twenty (20) and forty-two (42) security employees are active during periods of heavy occupancy.

- d. Maintenance of a detailed incident log for three years to be made available to any law enforcement entity or ABRA upon request.
- e. Detailed procedures for addressing underage individuals attempting to gain access.
- f. Detailed procedures addressing violent altercations in the establishment.
- g. Uniforms for security personnel, including visible club insignia.
- h. Institution and proof of criminal background checks on all present² and future security staff.
- i. Security training to be provided to all present security staff within 30 days of this agreement and to future security personnel within 60 days of hire (but prior to employment) with renewal training for all security staff on an annual basis.
- j. Security training that will cover: conflict resolution, procedures for handling violent incidents, other emergencies, and calling the police, procedures for crowd control and preventing overcrowding, and procedures for checking ID upon entry.
- k. Training on contacting MPD must require calls to 911 in event of incident inside premises that results in patron eviction by security staff, and calls to 911 when crime is observed or person is in obvious need of medical attention or requests such attention.
- l. Maintenance of detailed personnel files for all employees, including photocopies of employees' state-issued licenses and/or identification cards of each employee, to be made available to any law enforcement entity or ABRA upon request.
- m. Licensee is to have a representative available to meet periodically with the MPD District Commander or designee to review any issues concerning licensee operations or the activities of the security personnel.




