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**ORDER GRANTING APPLICANT'S REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL**

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Good Hope Market, LLC, t/a Dollar Plus Store (Applicant) applied for a New Retailer's Class A License (Application) at 1429 Good Hope Rd., S.E., Washington, D.C. Subsequently, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 8E protested the Application. The parties proceeded to a protest hearing on October 30, 2013; however, the record was reopened to reconsider allegations that the Applicant forged a signature and engaged in the sale of illegal synthetic marijuana. A new hearing was scheduled but never occurred, because the Applicant submitted a formal request to withdraw the Application. The Board accepts the withdrawal of the Application and, accordingly, dismisses the Application.

## ORDER

Therefore, the Board, on this 29th day of January 2014, hereby **GRANTS** the withdrawal filed by Good Hope Market, LLC, t/a Dollar Plus Store, and **DISMISSES** the Application for a New Retailer's Class A License.

Good Hope Market, LLC, Daniel Desta, and Hailu Tsion Gurmu are further **ADVISED** that all future applications for licensure submitted by the LLC, Mr. Desta, or Mr. Gurmu may be subject to review under D.C. Official Code § 25-301. The Board also reserves the right to rely on the record generated in this matter to make such a determination.





Under 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, under section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration under 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
