MR. DONOVAN W. ANDERSON: The next case on our calendar is Case #16-PRO-00035, Drafting Table, License #89190. Will the parties please approach and -- and identify yourself for the record, please?

MR. AARON GORDON: I'm Aaron Gordon. I'm the owner of, uh, Gordon Restaurant Group, uh, DBA Drafting Table.

MR. MALACHI BROADNAX: Malachi Broadnax, uh, head chef, general manager, acting partner, Drafting Table.

MR. DONOVAN W. ANDERSON: Have a seat. Uh, please, um, sign your name on the sign-in sheet out there, please.

(Silence)

MR. DONOVAN W. ANDERSON: This matter was scheduled for a 2:00 protest hearing. It is now 2:30 p.m. The ANC, ANC 2F, had protested the license. It's 2:30. ANC 2F is not here. We have not heard from ANC 2F whether or not they were

planning to appear.

And also, it's my understanding that although the licensee had filed their PIF within 7 days of this hearing, ANC 2F did not file a PIF.
