At its regularly scheduled meeting on November 3, 2011 (notice of which was properly given, and at which a quorum of seven of eleven members was present) ANC1B voted unanimously (7 yes, 0 no) to protest this application for a Retail Class B Grocery license on the basis of concerns relating to peace, order, quiet and parking, and apparent failures to comply with a current and binding voluntary agreement.
