1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 MS. FLETCHER: Would the parties in the  
3 matter of French Bistro Bistro and Lounge come forward,  
4 the parties in the matter of French Bistro Bistro, 1727  
5 Connecticut Avenue NW, License Number ABRA-081479. This  
6 is a Retailer Class CT, substantial change, sidewalk  
7 cafe with eight seats, and the Case Number is  
8 16-PRO-00080. My name is Laverne Fletcher. I'm  
9 conducting the roll call hearing as The Board's agent.  
10 Who's present on behalf of ANC 2B? Peter, would you  
11 spell [inaudible].

12 MR. SACCO: Peter Sacco. I'm the executive  
13 director of ANC 2B.

14 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And, Mr. Sacco,  
15 would you spell your last name please.

16 MR. SACCO: Yeah. It's Sacco, S-A-C-C-O.

17 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you very much. And,  
18 Mr. Sacco, would you put your contact information on  
19 that sheet if you didn't already.

20 MR. SACCO: I already did.

21 MS. FLETCHER: Thank you. And so the  
22 applicant is not present today, Mr. Sacco. And my

1 understanding is that the ANC previously submitted a  
2 withdrawal letter for the protest.

3 MR. SACCO: Yes. We submitted a settlement  
4 agreement through the normal e-mail chain, the process  
5 we do. That was last Wednesday. In that submission the  
6 settlement agreement communicated in the e-mail was that  
7 the would be ANC dropping its protest.

8 MS. FLETCHER: In that case I will not  
9 dismiss the substantial change application. I'm  
10 assuming the applicant is not here because he's aware  
11 that a settlement --

12 MR. SACCO: You got it.

13 MS. FLETCHER: He signed a settlement  
14 agreement. And so I will just -- we'll just now have a  
15 record, Mr. Sacco, that the ANC withdrew the protest.

16 MR. SACCO: Great.

17 MS. FLETCHER: And thank you for coming.

18 MR. SACCO: No problem.

19 MS. FLETCHER: The roll call hearing has  
20 concluded.
