
On May 16, 2016, the Board dismissed the Protest of SDCA, because SDCA did not give the Applicant at least seven days advanced notice of the SDCA meeting, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-601(3)(B). SDCA may file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

## **ORDER**

The Board does hereby, this 18<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2016, **DISMISS** the Protest of SDCA. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant, ANC 1B, and Guy Podgornik, on behalf of SDCA.

The Board advises the parties that the protest of ANC 1B remains, and the Protest Status Hearing is set for June 15, 2016 at 9:30 a.m. and the Protest Hearing for July 27, 2016 at 1:30 p.m.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
