**ORDER GRANTING PROTESTANT'S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE AND

HGH 1610, LLC (Applicant), was scheduled to appear before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Protest Status Hearing on May 2, 2012, at 9:30 a.m., and a Protest Hearing on June 13, 2012, at 1:30 p.m.

The Protestant submitted a Motion to Dismiss or in the Alternative, for a Continuance, dated April 24, 2012. On May 1, 2012, the Protestant withdrew its Motion to Dismiss the Applicant's Application.

Therefore, the Board **GRANTED** the Protestant's request to continue the Protest Status Hearing and the Protest Hearing to a later date.






