**ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST**

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) has been notified by the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs (DCRA) that Superclub Ibiza, LLC, t/a Ibiza's (Licensee), at premises 1222 1<sup>st</sup> Street, N.E., Washington, D.C., is operating with an expired Basic Business License (BBL), in violation of D.C. Official Code § 47-2851.02(a). DCRA determined that Ibiza's BBL expired on June 2013. In accordance with the laws and regulations of the District of Columbia, the Licensee shall not engage in the sale or service of alcoholic beverages unless its BBL is in good standing.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 you are therefore **ORDERED** by the Board on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2014, to **STOP selling, serving, or permitting the consumption of alcoholic beverages under your Retailer's Class CN License No. ABRA-074456**. You may not allow the sale of alcoholic beverages until your ABC License is reinstated by the Board.

**NOTICE TO DISCONTINUE UNLICENSED BUSINESS ACTIVITY**

This is official notice from the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs (“DCRA”) that Superclub Ibiza, LLC (“Ibiza”), is in violation of D.C. Official Code §47-2851.02(a), which requires businesses such as Ibiza to first secure a Basic Business License before conducting business in the District of Columbia.

On March 28, 2014, members of the District of Columbia Noise Task Force, including DCRA personnel, conducted a site inspection of Ibiza. On the basis of that inspection, DCRA determined that Ibiza’s Basic Business License expired on June 2013, and that Ibiza is currently operating a restaurant at the location, 1222 First Street, N.E., without a Basic Business Public Health: Food Establishment Retail License endorsement. Notwithstanding your prior operation without the Basic Business Public Health: Food Establishment Retail License endorsement, based on your occupancy of 1,375, you meet the threshold for a Public Hall license and are now required to secure the Public Hall license to continue any operations at the establishment.

In order to secure the proper licensure, Ibiza is required to file an application with the Business and Professional Licensing Administration for a Public Hall license and comply with all requirements as outlined in DC Official Code § 47-2820 et seq. Until Ibiza receives the required licenses, Ibiza is directed to discontinue all business activity at 1222 First Street, N.E.

If it is discovered that Ibiza continues to operate in violation of the District of Columbia licensing statutes, this matter may be referred to the Office of the Attorney General for criminal and/or civil prosecution. The criminal penalty for operating without a business license is three hundred dollars (\$300), or imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days.

Civil Fines, penalties, and fees may also be imposed as alternative sanctions of the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs Civil Infractions Act of 1985 (the “Act”), or any rules and regulations issued under the authority of this Act, pursuant to Titles I-III of the Act. Adjudication of any infraction of the Act shall be pursuant to Titles I-III of the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs Civil Infractions Act of 1985. See D.C. Official Code § 47-2846. Operating without a license in the District of Columbia is a Class 1 infraction, 16 DCMR § 3301.1(u), which carries a fine of \$2,000 for the first offense. Subsequent offenses may incur higher fines with a \$16,000.00 fine for the fourth and subsequent offenses. This notice does not absolve the District from pursuing these additional penalties.


