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**ORDER VACATING BOARD ORDER NO. 2016-640**

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The application filed by Juanita's, Inc., t/a Juanita's Restaurant (Applicant), for renewal of its Retailer's Class CT License, having been protested by Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 1A, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing (Hearing) on November 7, 2016, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001). ANC 1A failed to appear at the Hearing on November 7 and the Board dismissed its protest on November 9, 2016. *See in the Matter of Juanita's, Inc., t/a Juanita's Restaurant*, Board Order No. 2016-640 (D.C.A.B.C.B. November 9, 2016).

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration's (ABRA) records reveal that prior to the Hearing, ANC 1A notified the agency, in writing, that it was entering into a


new voluntary agreement with the Applicant, that it was withdrawing its protest, and that it did not intend to send a representative to the Hearing.


Based on a complete review of ABRA's records, ANC 1A's protest was dismissed erroneously.


Accordingly, it is this 16<sup>th</sup> day of November 2016, **ORDERED** that:


1. Board Order No. 2016-640 is vacated;
2. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant and ANC 1A.





Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).

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**ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF ANC 1A'S PROTEST**

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

**ORDER**


