**ORDER ON WITHDRAWAL OF PROTEST**



By correspondence dated June 8, 2016, Charles Marr, on behalf of Velocity Condominium Association, Inc., withdrew its protest in this matter.


After reviewing the request, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, on this 15th day of June, 2016, deems the Protest **WITHDRAWN**.

Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant and Charles Marr, Board President, on behalf of Velocity Condominium Association, Inc.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
