ORDER DENYING PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

The official records of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) reflect that Khan's BBQ, Inc., t/a Khan's, (Petitioner), and ANC 6A have entered into a Settlement Agreement (Agreement), dated May 2, 2013, that governs the operation of the Petitioner's establishment. On June 5, 2013, the Board approved the Settlement Agreement. *See* Board Order No. 2013-254.

On June 13, 2013, the Petitioner submitted a Motion for Reconsideration requesting that the Board reverse Board Order No. 2013-254 on Settlement Agreement, dated May 2, 2013, between the Petitioner and ANC 6A. The Petitioner states that he did not fully understand the Agreement when he signed it due to his limited understanding of English and the law.

The Board finds that the Petitioner knowingly entered into the Settlement Agreement and consented to its terms and conditions. As such, the Board will not now set the Settlement Agreement aside.

ORDER







Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (April 2004) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b).
