ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by Khan's BBQ, Inc., t/a Khan's, Applicant, for a new Retailer's Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) for a Status Hearing on July 14, 2010 in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).


On July 14, 2010, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("23 DCMR") § 1603.3 (2004), the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) dismissed the Group of Five or More Individuals, represented by Robert Pittman, for failure to appear timely at the Status Hearing. Mr. Pittman, on behalf of the Group of Five or More Individuals, timely filed a request for reinstatement with the Board, explaining the reasons for not appearing timely. Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Protestants, the Board finds good cause to reinstate Protestants pursuant to 23 DCMR 1603.3.






