**ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF INDIVIDUAL PROTESTANTS
AND PROTEST OF GACDTF**

The Application filed by Shin & Jang, Inc., t/a King's Deli & Grocery, for a new Retailer's Class A License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on November 21, 2011, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On November 21, 2011, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (23 DCMR) § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed Monica Gantt, Trena Green, and Jennifer P. Tate as protestants with the Group of Five or More Individuals, because they did not sign the protest letter. The Board also dismissed Courtney Applequist as a protestant with the Group of Five or More Individuals, because she designated herself as her representative, but Ms. Applequist failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing.

In addition, the Board dismissed the Protest of GACDTF, because the organization is not a civic association incorporated in the District of Columbia, as required by the D.C. Official Code § 25-601(3).

Monica Gantt, Trena Green, Jennifer P. Tate, Courtney Applequist, and GACDTF may file a Request for Reinstatement within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

ORDER

The Board does hereby, this 30th day of November, 2011, **DISMISS** Monica Gantt, Trena Green, Jennifer P. Tate, and Courtney Applequist as protestants with the Group of Five or More Individuals, and the Protest of GACDTF.
