**ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION
AND REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE**

On September 30, 2015, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer Class B License ABRA-002109 held by Sook C. Kim, t/a Kusa Market (Petitioner), located at 3108 Georgia Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C., because the Petitioner surrendered his license for cancellation. *See* Board Order No. 2015-439.

On October 23, 2015, Mr. Sook Kim sought reinstatement of his Retailer's Class B License No. ABRA-002109. In support of his Request for Reconsideration, Mr. Kim stated that his precipitated decision to surrender his license was based on difficult personal circumstances. He now informs the Board that he wants to resume the operation of his business.

On September 28, 2015, the Licensee paid the license fees for the period of 2015 to 2016.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper.

Accordingly, it is this 4th day of November, 2015, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against Sook C. Kim, t/a Kusa Market, by the Board on September 30, 2015, be and hereby is **VACATED**.


It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that its Retailer Class B License ABRA-002109 be **REINSTATED**.

A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Petitioner.





Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
