1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: our next case on
3 our show cause hearing calendar is Case #16-CMP-
4 00155, Langston Bar and Grill, license #86271.
5 Will the parties please approach and identify
6 themselves for the record, please?

7 MR. RIVERO: Good morning, board members,
8 Fernando Rivero for the District of Columbia.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr.
10 Rivero. I noticed that the licensee is not here.
11 But does the government wish to make a
12 preliminary statement?

13 MR. RIVERO: Yes, the government has a
14 preliminary matter which explains the licensee's
15 absence. The government would like to dismiss
16 the case at this time. The licensee has actually
17 paid the fine prior to this date.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The government is
19 making a motion to dismiss this matter, right?

20 MR. RIVERO: Oh, I -- for the record, I
21 forgot. Paid the fine prior to this hearing as
22 to charge #1, but much longer ago than that the

1 licensee had paid the fine as to charge #2, so
2 both are paid. There are two charges in this
3 case from two different citations and both
4 citations are paid.

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And so, with that
6 said, the government is asking the board to
7 dismiss this matter? All right. Is there a
8 second?

9 MR. ALBERTI: Second.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Alberti has
11 seconded the motion. Those in favor say aye.
12 (chorus of ayes.) Those opposed? (no audible
13 response.) The case has been dismissed based on
14 the government's motion to dismiss the matter
15 because the fine has been paid. Thank you, Mr.
16 Rivero.
