1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The first case on
3 the docket is Case No. 15-AUD-00089, La Dulce
4 Noche, License No. 92426. Will the parties
5 please approach.

6 MR. RIVERO: Good morning, board members.
7 Fernando Rivero for the District of Columbia
8 standing in for Amy Schmidt.

9 MR. SOLLOSO: Jose Solloso from La Dulce
10 Noche restaurant.

11 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Good morning, sir.
12 How are you doing? Are there any preliminary
13 matters?

14 MR. RIVERO: Yes. The parties have an
15 offer in compromise to present to the board at
16 this time.

17 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: And what is the offer
18 in compromise, please?

19 MR. RIVERO: It consists of a fine of
20 \$1,250 payable in 30 days. If the fine is not
21 paid in 30 days, the license will be suspended
22 until the payment is received, and the licensee

1 is to maintain invoices going forward. I think
2 the licensee may have actually brought a check
3 today. That's the offer in compromise.

4 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: All right. Thank
5 you. I just want the record to reflect Mr.
6 Alberti has joined us.

7 Mr. Solloso --

8 MR. SOLLOSO: Solloso.

9 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: -- the governed has
10 stated that there's an offer in compromise of
11 \$1,250 fine that will be paid within 30 days.
12 That if it's not paid within 30 days, that a
13 license will be suspended; that you will maintain
14 invoices going forward. Is this your
15 understanding of the offer in compromise, sir?

16 MR. SOLLOSO: Yes, sir.

17 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: And are you aware
18 that by accepting an offer in compromise, you
19 give up your right to a hearing?

20 MR. SOLLOSO: Yes, I do.

21 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: And you're also aware
22 that you also give up your right to an appeal?

1 MR. SOLLOSO: Yes, I do.

2 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: All right.

3 Does any board members have any questions
4 on this offer in compromise?

5 Seeing none, I move that this offer in
6 compromise of a \$1,250 fine paid within 30 days,
7 and if it's not paid in 30 days, the license will
8 be suspended. And that the licensee maintain
9 invoices going forward. Is there a second?

10 MR. SHORT: Second.

11 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
12 seconded the motion. Those in favor say aye.

13 [Chorus of Ayes.]

14 Those opposed?

15 The matter has passes 5-0-0. Thank you.
