ORDER DENYING REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by Bud and Papa, Inc., t/a Layla Lounge, for a Renewal of its Retailer's Class CT License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board ("Board") for a Roll Call Hearing on November 22, 2010, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On November 22, 2010, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("23 DCMR") § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed the Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. The Applicant filed a request for reinstatement with the Board explaining the reasons for not appearing. Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Application, the Board does not find good cause to reinstate Applicant pursuant to 23 D.C.M.R. 1602.3.

ORDER





Bud and Papa, Inc t/a Layla Lounge, 501 Morse Street, NE, Washington, DC 20002 acknowledges the pending status of the CT License Renewal, License No. **ABRA-079238**, Case No. **10-PRO-00151**, however we would like to request a subsequent roll call hearing date to meet with the **ANC5B** to address the matters of opposition. During this meeting **Bud and Papa, Inc t/a Layla Lounge** would like to address all prominent issues and concerns that are in questioning. We were unable to commit to the previous scheduled hearing date, November 22, 2010, due to a delay in the allocation of U.S. Postal mail. Also, we would like to establish a realm of communication with **ANC5B** to review the legalities and regulations of the operating business with high expectations of reaching an agreement of unanimous consensus.

Matters in questioning:

- (x) adversely impacts on the peace, order and quiet in the neighborhood;
- (x) adversely impacts on residential parking vehicular and pedestrian safety in the area
- (x) adversely impacts on real property values;
- (x) other: public safety issues
