**ORDER DENYING PETITIONER'S REQUEST FOR  
REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE**

On May 23, 2012, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled Fantazia Corporation's, t/a Legends Restaurant & Carry Out, (Petitioner), License No. ABRA-073982, a Retailer's Class DR License, for failure to pay its license fees for the period of 2012 to 2013. *See* Board Order No. 2012-225. ABRA mailed the Order to the Licensee at his address of record and no returned mail was received by ABRA.

On July 31, 2014, the Petitioner sought reinstatement of its Retailer's Class DR License No. ABRA-073982, located at 2157 P Street, N.W. The Petitioner stated that on July 24, 2014, he learned that his license was cancelled. He indicated that in 2011, he placed the license in Safekeeping. He claimed that he was not notified by ABRA that the license fees were due, nor did he believe fees were due because the license was in Safekeeping.

The Petitioner has agreed to pay all back license fees and late fees associated with the previously cancelled license.

Notwithstanding the Petitioner's efforts to resurrect its business, the Board finds that too much time has lapsed between the 2012 license cancellation and the 2014 request to reinstate the license. Therefore, the Petitioner's request for reinstatement of the license is denied.


### **ORDER**


