1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case on our
3 calendar is Case Number 16-PRO-00041, Mason &
4 Rook/Radiator, License Number 79243. Will the parties
5 please approach and identify themselves for the record
6 please.

7 MR. MINORA: Good morning. My name is
8 Matthew Minora from the firm Mallios & O'Brien on behalf
9 of the licensee.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning.

11 MR. HAGUE: Hi. Good morning. Chris Hague,
12 LaSalle Hotel Properties, ownership of the hotel.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Is the ANC here?
14 Any -- any parties from the ANC? I'll -- this matter
15 was scheduled for a 9:30. I will recall this case.
16 I'll be fair. I'll give them until 10:00. I'll recall
17 this case at 10:00. If they are not here at 10:00, I'll
18 dismiss their protest. All right. So thank you.

19 (Whereupon, the above-entitled matter was
20 recalled.)

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The --
22 recalling Case Number 16-PRO-00041, Mason &

1 Rook/Radiator, License Number 79243. Will the parties
2 please approach and identify themselves for the record

4 MR. MINORA: Matthew Minora from the firm
5 Mallios & O'Brien on behalf of the licensee.

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning again.

7 MR. HAGUE: Chris Hague with LaSalle Hotel
8 Properties, ownership.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning. The
10 protestant is not here. This matter was scheduled for a
11 protest hearing status at 9:30. It's 10:06. So
12 therefore the protest is -- is dismissed.

13 All -- what this means is that they have an
14 opportunity to request that The Board reconsider the
15 matter and The Board will -- if -- if The Board
16 determines that good cause why they're not here, The
17 Board might consider their request if they file it. If
18 they don't -- if they do not file, then there's --
19 you'll get your license, and there is no issue.

20 But there is a period of time for them to --
21 we'll inform them that they have been dismissed. They
22 will -- if they respond within a reasonable period of

1 time and if they ask for reconsideration, The Board will
2 make that determination. Okay. And then of course if
3 they ask for reconsideration your attorney will have an
4 opportunity to either say that we'll -- we -- we'll say
5 that The Board should grant or deny. But as of today
6 since they are not here, the -- their protest has been
7 dismissed. All right. Thank you very much for being
8 here.

9 MR. MINORA: Okay. Thank you.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The Mason
11 & Rook/Radiator.
