1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 ROLL CALL HEARING

3 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Would the parties
4 in the matter of My Canton Restaurant please come
5 forward? The parties in the matter of My Canton.
6 This is Case #16-PRO-00075, Family's Corporation
7 trading as My Canton Restaurant, 1772 Columbia
8 Road Northwest, License #ABRA-075479. This is a
9 Retailer Class CR, Substantial Change of Sidewalk
10 Café with 8 seats. The protest issues are
11 adverse impact on peace, order and quiet. My
12 name is Laverne Fletcher and I'm conducting the
13 roll call hearing as the Board's agent.
14 Introductions beginning with the applicant
15 please. Good morning.

16 MR. POLIO: Good morning. My name is
17 Jose Polio.

18 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: J-O-S-E?

19 MR. POLIO: Mm hmm.

20 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: P-P-O-

21 MR. POLIO: -P-O-L-I-O.

22 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: L-I-O?

1 MR. POLIO: Polio.

2 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Polio, okay. And
3 your name?

4 MS. POLIO-RIOS: My name is Keiry Polio-
5 Rios. I'm his daughter and a translator today.

6 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Oh, okay. Let me
7 -- spell your first name for me.

8 MS. POLIO-RIOS: K-E-I-R-Y.

9 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Okay and what's
10 the last name again?

11 MS. POLIO: Polio, P-O-L-I-O, and then
12 there's a space and RIOS.

13 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Okay, thank you
14 very much. So you're translating for your dad
15 today?

16 MS. POLIO-RIOS: Yeah.

17 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: So, let me ask you
18 this, Mr. Polio. For future proceedings would
19 you want us to provide a translator? We can if
20 you --

21 MR. POLIO: Yeah.

22 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Okay, so we'll do

1 that. And thank you for coming today.

2 MS. POLIO-RIOS: It's okay.

3 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Mr. Polio, you
4 need to put your contact information on that
5 sheet.

6 MR. POLIO: I already did.

7 MS. POLIO-RIOS: Do I have to?

8 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: You can just write
9 your name so that I'll know you were here and
10 then put that you're his daughter/interpreter
11 just so we know that you were here, that's fine,
12 and then for Mr. Polio, you can see we need his
13 e-mail address and telephone number for daytime.

14 MR. POLIO-RIOS: Okay.

15 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Present on behalf
16 of ANC 1C?

17 MR. GUTHRIE: Ted Guthrie.

18 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Mr. Guthrie, would
19 you spell your name for the record, please?

20 MR. GUTHRIE: T-E-D, G-U-T-H-R-I-E.
21 Julie Siewell is going to be the person
22 principally responsible for this --

1 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Mr. Guthrie, how
2 does she spell her name?

3 MR. GUTHRIE: J-U-L-I-E, S-I-E-W-E-L-L, I
4 believe. I never remember whether it's I-E or E-
5 I.

6 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Do you know her
7 contact information?

8 MR. GUTHRIE: I can show it to you.

9 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: So, what we'll do
10 if it comes in after the report has gone in for
11 today, then the official hearing notice will come
12 to you and I know that you would forward it to
13 her. Okay.

14 MR. GUTHRIE: No problem.

15 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: I'll put in the
16 record who's representing you in this case,
17 though.

18 MR. GUTHRIE: I could even make like,
19 let's see here, we already have status, protest
20 and mediation times on a case that should have
21 been consolidated with this and I didn't
22 understand why it wasn't.

1 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Oh. Which one is
2 that, Mr. Guthrie? Mediation date available?

3 MR. GUTHRIE: The mediation date is 08/04
4 at 11:00.

5 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Yeah, 8/04, here
6 it is right here.

7 MR. GUTHRIE: Yeah, and I don't know why
8 these weren't consolidated to start with.

9 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Well, we can do
10 them at the same time --

11 MR. GUTHRIE: Okay.

12 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: -- if that works
13 for you, Mr. Guthrie.

14 MR. GUTHRIE: I think that would
15 certainly be most efficient.

16 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: We can -- you have
17 another mediation scheduled for August the 4th --

18 MR. POLIO: The same day and the same
19 time?

20 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Yes, we'll just do
21 them at the same time.

22 MR. POLIO: I think that was --

1 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: At 11:00.

2 MR. POLIO: At 11:00?

3 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Yes. We're going
4 to do them at 11:00.

5 MR. POLIO: That's fine.

6 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Oh, yes.

7 MR. GUTHRIE: Do you need the status and
8 protest or do you already have that?

9 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: We have a
10 different one for this case. So, what I'm going
11 to have to do, I'm going to have to give you the
12 dates that they've given me --

13 MR. GUTHRIE: Okay.

14 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: -- and then, so
15 Mr. Guthrie, you're probably going to request the
16 same status date for the next one, right?

17 MR. GUTHRIE: Right.

18 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Okay, and so I'll
19 let them know that's coming.

20 MR. GUTHRIE: Okay, so just send that to
21 Martha?

22 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Yes, Mm hmm. And

1 so the status date for this one is set for
2 September the 14th at 9:30, and the protest
3 hearing is set for November 2nd, at 4:30. And
4 so, Mr. Guthrie, I'll let Martha know that the
5 request is coming to put both of these on the
6 same status date.

7 MR. GUTHRIE: Great.

8 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Okay, so mediation
9 is set for August 4 at 11:00. Any questions at
10 all?

11 MR. POLIO: No.

12 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: So, Mr. Canton
13 (sic) I will request a Spanish language
14 interpreter for the mediation on August the 4th,
15 and for the status hearing and for the protest
16 hearing.

17 MS. POLIO-RIOS: Thank you.

18 MR. POLIO: Thank you.

19 MR. GUTHRIE: Thank you.

21 roll call hearing is concluded.
