ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Petition to Terminate a Voluntary Agreement (Petition) filed by 2461 Corporation, t/a Madam's Organ Lounge (Petitioner), having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on April 4, 2011, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On April 4, 2011, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("23 DCMR") § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed the Petition because the Petitioner failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing.

On April 18, 2011, Attorney Richard Bianco, on behalf of the Petitioner, filed a Motion for Reinstatement of Petition indicating that he, as the attorney of record, was not provided with notice of the Roll Call Hearing and the Petitioner, after speaking with ABRA staff, believed that new placards with a new Roll Call date would be received because of the errant inclusion of KCA. Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the


Petitioner, the Board finds good cause to reinstate the Petitioner.


ORDER


