ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by Sula, LLC, t/a Masa 14, for a Substantial Change to its Retailer's Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) for a Roll Call Hearing on March 1, 2010, and for a Status Hearing before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) on April 7, 2010, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).


On April 7, 2010, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("23 DCMR") § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed the Protest of the Group of Five because three additional protestants from this Group of Five failed to appear at the Status Hearing. Because only two of the protestants from the Group of Five appeared at the Roll Call Hearing, the other three were required to appear at the Status Hearing.

The Group of Five timely filed a request for reinstatement with the Board on April 13, 2010, explaining the reasons for not appearing. Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the protest of the Group of Five, the Board finds good cause to reinstate the Group of Five pursuant to 23 D.C.M.R. 1602.3. In addition, all five protestants from the Group of Five must appear at the Protest Hearing on May 12, 2010.

ORDER

For these reasons, the Board does hereby, this 28th day of April, 2010, **REINSTATE** the Group of Five as a Protestant of the Application filed by Sula, LLC, t/a Masa 14, for a Substantial Change to its Retailer's Class CR License. Further, all five protestants from the Group of Five must appear at the Protest Hearing on May 12, 2010. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Protestants and the Applicant.


