ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE

On December 1, 2014, the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration's (ABRA) Enforcement Division determined that Obsidian, LLC, t/a Mayalen, has ceased operations.

On January 14, 2015, the ABRA's Licensing Division notified the Licensee via email that if it is no longer in operations, the license must be surrendered to the Board for safekeeping or the license will be cancelled, pursuant to the District of Columbia Official Code § 25-791. The Licensee acknowledged receipt of the email but has not submitted a Safekeeping Application with ABRA.

It is hereby **ORDERED** on this 18th day of February, 2015, that Obsidian, LLC's License No. ABRA-088686 is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Licensee.

Under 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
