**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND  
REINSTATING LICENSE**

On April 29, 2015, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2015-231 cancelling Odaly's Restaurant, LLC, t/a Odaly's Restaurant, (Licensee) License No. ABRA-097025. Specifically, the Licensee failed to make the third year payment for its license by March 31, 2015, the deadline for all Retailer's Class CR licenses, despite being notified by ABRA of the payment date. *See* Board Order No. 2015-231.

On March 10, 2016, the owner of the establishment, Jose S. Argueta, sought reinstatement of his Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-097025. In support of his request for reinstatement, Mr. Argueta stated that he did not receive the written notice mailed by the Licensing Division. Thus, he failed to make the third year payment for his license.


On March 17, 2016, the Licensee paid the license fees for the period of 2015 to 2016 and the associated late fees.


The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper.

It is hereby **ORDERED**, that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against Odaly's Restaurant, LLC, t/a Odaly's Restaurant, located at 1200 Kennedy Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., by the Board on April 29, 2015, be and hereby is **VACATED** and that the Retailer Class CR License No. ABRA-097025 is **REINSTATED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Licensee.





Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
