The Application filed by Café Dallul, Inc., t/a Rendezvous Lounge, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CT License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on December 2, 2013, and a Protest Status Hearing on January 29, 2014, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On January 29, 2014, the Board purposely left the record open for over 30 minutes to allow for tardy appearances of all parties. At 10:19 a.m., the Board's Chairman called Case No. 13-PRO-00159 and no one appeared on behalf of the Applicant. (See Transcript, 1/29/14 at 16-17).

ORDER







Pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (April 2004), any Party adversely affected by this Order may file a Motion for Reconsideration within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b).
