ORDER DENYING PETITION TO TERMINATE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The official records of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) reflect that Kochhar Inc. t/a S&S Liquors, (Petitioner), entered into a Settlement Agreement with Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 4B, the Takoma Orange Hat Patrol, The Takoma Neighborhood Watch, the Takoma Orange Hat Patrol, the Watkins Condominium Association, the Neighbors, Inc., and Plan Takoma, Inc. on June 23, 1997¹. This Settlement Agreement was approved by the Board on June 25, 1997. The Petitioner now seeks to terminate its Settlement Agreement under D.C. Official Code § 25-446(d).

The Board finds that the Petitioner submitted an incomplete petition to terminate its Settlement Agreement on March 27, 2015. The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) notified the Petitioner that its petition failed to include all necessary information and documents required to terminate its Settlement Agreement on March 27, 2015. Further, ABRA informed the Petitioner that it had until the end of the Retailer's Class A renewal period, March 31, 2015, to cure the deficiencies of the Petition. Nevertheless, the Petitioner failed to amend its Petition to comply with the statutory requirements.


Therefore, based upon the above, the Board denies the Petition to Terminate the Settlement Agreement due to the Petitioner's submission of an incomplete Petition.

ORDER

Therefore, the Board, on this 8th day of April 2015, hereby **DENIES** the Petition to Terminate a Settlement Agreement submitted by Kochhar Inc. t/a S&S Liquors.

The ABRA shall deliver a copy of this order to the Petitioner.





Pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).

ⁱ ABRA records indicate that this underlying Settlement Agreement was entered into by the previous holder of the license, BBJ, Inc. t/a S&S Liquors. However, the Petitioner has assumed the Retailer's Class A license by a transfer in 2009 and therefore assumes the duties and responsibilities of the licensed establishment set forth in the Settlement Agreement among the parties.
