Re: Sunday Alcoholic Beverage Sales

Dear Class A Licensee:

On December 18, 2012, the Council adopted Bill Number 19-1101, the Omnibus Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Emergency Amendment Act of 2012. The Bill amends section 25-722 of the D.C. Code to allow eligible Class A retailer's licensees to apply to the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) to sell and deliver alcoholic beverages on Sundays. The hours that alcoholic beverages are permitted to be sold and delivered on Sundays are between 7 a.m. and midnight.

Eligible licensees are required to file the attached "Change of Hours Application" with ABRA to request Sunday hours. This application is also available on ABRA's website at [www.abra.dc.gov](http://www.abra.dc.gov). ABRA will begin accepting applications to sell and deliver alcoholic beverages on Sundays on **Wednesday, January 16, 2013**. The holder of a Class A retailer's license who does not wish to sell or deliver alcoholic beverages on Sundays is not required to do so. There is no fee to apply.

Class A retailer's licensees are eligible to request Sunday hours only if (1) the licensee does not have a voluntary agreement, or (2) the voluntary agreement does not contain any restrictions on operating or selling alcoholic beverages on Sundays.
