ORDER VACATING CEASE AND DESIST

On October 23, 2013, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2013-473 ordering Terfneh Kahsay, t/a Salina Restaurant (Respondent), holder of a Retailer's Class CT License No. ABRA-082969, to stop selling, serving, or permitting the consumption of alcoholic beverages at its establishment until the Respondent pays the required renewal fee and any associated fines owed to the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration.

On October 24, 2013, the Respondent paid the renewal fee and the associated late fees.



Effective October 24, 2013.




