On May 9, 2011, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("23 DCMR") § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed Olga Rios as a protestant with the Group of Five or More Individuals, because she did not sign the protest letter. Olga Rios may file a Request for Reinstatement within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

The Board also confirms that the ANC 2A filed a timely protest and is granted standing.




**ORDER**


