**ORDER APPROVING OFFER-IN-COMPROMISE AND
CANCELLING LICENSE**

Acott Ventures, t/a Shadow Room (Respondent) is the holder of a Retailer's Class CR License (License), located at 2131 K Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20037.


On November 12, 2016, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) served a Notice of Status and Show Cause Hearings (Notice) for Case No. 16-CC-00044, dated November 10, 2016, on Respondent, charging it with the following:

Charge I: [On Sunday, April 1, 2016], [y]ou permitted the sale of an alcoholic beverage to a person under the age of twenty-one (21) years, in violation of D.C. Official Code § 25-781(a).

The matter came before the Board for a Show Cause Status Hearing on December 7, 2016. At that time, the Office of the Attorney General for the District of Columbia (Government) proposed, pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1611.5, and the Respondent accepted, an Offer-in-Compromise (OIC) in order to resolve the pending Charge. The OIC consisted of the Respondent surrendering its License to ABRA and the immediate cancellation thereof. The Board voted to accept the OIC, five (5) to zero (0).

For the foregoing reasons, it is hereby **ORDERED** on this 7th day of December, 2016, that Acott Ventures, t/a Shadow Room, License No. ABRA-075871, is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent and the Government.





Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
