**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE  
AND REINSTATING LICENSE**

On January 28, 2015, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer Class CR License ABRA-076125 held by Sisy's Salvadorean & Mexican Restaurant, Inc., t/a Sisy's (Petitioner), located at 3911 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., because the Petitioner had ceased operations. *See* Board Order No. 2015-031.

Specifically, on November 21, 2014, the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration's Licensing Division mailed via Unites States Postal Service (USPS) a written notice to the Petitioner. This notice advised the Petitioner that if it was no longer operational, the license must be surrendered to the Board for safekeeping or the license would be cancelled pursuant to the District of Columbia Official Code § 25-791. ABRA mailed the notice to the Petitioner at her address of record, but the notice was returned undeliverable to ABRA.

On July 30, 2015, Susana Galeas, on behalf of the Petitioner, submitted correspondence to informing ABRA that she sold her business and that she did not receive the written notice mailed by the Licensing Division. Thus, she was unaware that she was required to place her license in Safekeeping or risk cancellation. Ms. Galeas now seeks to have her license reinstated.

The Board required the Petitioner to pay all the pending license fees and the associated late fees as a condition of reinstatement. On September 4, 2015, the Petitioner paid the license fees for the period of 2015 to 2016 and the associated late fees.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper.

It is hereby **ORDERED**, that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against Sisy's Salvadorean & Mexican Restaurant, Inc., t/a Sisy's, by the Board on January 28, 2015, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that its Retailer Class CR License ABRA-076125 be **REINSTATED**.

A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Petitioner.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
