ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

On September 10, 2014, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) reviewed information sent by the Office of Chief Financial Officer (OCFO) that four checks submitted by GBP, LLC, t/a Tacklebox, ("Tacklebox") to the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration were returned unpaid. Specifically, OCFO reported that one check for the amount of \$1,000 and three checks in the amount of \$1,666.66 were returned unpaid.

Under § 208.3,

The Board may suspend a license, permit, or endorsement where payment was made by the applicant to ABRA with a check returned unpaid. The applicant, in addition to any late fees imposed by the Board pursuant to § 208.2, shall also be charged by ABRA with a one hundred dollar (\$100) returned check fee.

23 DCMR § 208.3 (West Supp. 2014). Under these circumstances, the Board concludes that Tacklebox merits suspension of its license under § 208.3.

ORDER

Therefore, the Board on this 10th day of September 2014, hereby orders Tacklebox to **CEASE AND DESIST** selling, serving, or permitting the consumption of alcohol at its premises in accordance with D.C. Official Code §§ 25-829(a) and 23 DCMR § 208.3.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the suspension shall not be lifted until the licensee remits \$400 in returned check fees in accordance with § 208.3.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the suspension shall not be lifted until the licensee pays all money owed to the agency.

Please be **ADVISED** that a copy of this Order is being forwarded to the Metropolitan Police Department to ensure compliance. If it is found that you are continuing to sell, serve, or permit the consumption of alcoholic beverages without approval from the Board, you may be subject to both civil and criminal penalties.

ABRA shall deliver this Order by certified mail or personal delivery in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-829(a).






