The Application filed by India Palace, LLC, t/a Taj of India, for a Substantial Change to include a new Summer Garden, to its Retailer's Class CR License, located at 2807-2809 M Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., having been protested. The Roll Call Hearing was scheduled for January 22, 2013.

On January 21, 2013, Commissioners Tom Birch and Bill Starrels, on behalf of ANC 2E, submitted correspondence indicating that it was withdrawing its protest because the Applicant amended the hours of operation and sales of the Summer Garden to read: Sunday through Thursday 11:00 a.m. – 11:30 p.m., and Friday and Saturday 11:00 a.m. – 12:00 a.m.






