**ORDER ON DISMISSAL OF PROTESTANTS OF
A GROUP OF FIVE OR MORE INDIVIDUALS**

The Application filed by The Old Naval Hospital Foundation, t/a The Old Naval Hospital Foundation, for a new Retailer's Class CX Multipurpose License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on July 18, 2011, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

Initially, there were two Groups of Five or More Individuals consisting of approximately 148 Individuals, which were merged into one group. The following individuals were present at the Roll Call Hearing: Carie Haes, Jill Lawrence, Vivian Ault, Robert Ault, Paul Malvey, Thomas Riehle, Barbara Riehle, Peter Riehle, Joanne Kim, Richard Parsons, Bob Barrow, Gini Kennedy and Kenneth Cooper. The following individuals were not present at the Roll Call Hearing: L. Manon Therox, Daniel Chudnov, Joseph M. Shea, Rowena Shea, Paul Sickler, Sean Enkiri, Helene Quick, Rayna Green, Ilya Libenman, Sheila Fleishell, John J. Myers, and Robert Cantillion, but they designated Jill Lawrence and Pope Barrow as their representatives; and Barvara Eck and Michael Eck designated Keneth Cooper as their representative.

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On July 18 2011, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (“23 DCMR”) § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed the remaining 121 Individuals as protestants with the Group of Five or More Individuals for failure to appear at the Roll Call Hearing and they did not designate a representative. The Individuals dismissed by the Board may file a Request for Reinstatement within ten (10) days from the date of this Order.

ORDER

The Board does hereby, this 27th day of July, 2011, **DISMISS** the Individuals of the Group of Five or More Individuals not present at the Roll Call Hearing and did not designate a representative.

Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant and the 148 members of the Group of Five or More Individuals.






