
ORDER RESCINDING APPROVAL OF ABRA LICENSE NO. ABRA-090850

The Sequoia Presidential Yacht Group, LLC (Applicant), filed an Application for a Retailer's Class CX Marine Vessel License (Application) at 600 Water Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. The Application was approved under 23 DCMR § 405.1, which authorizes the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) to issue a license to an applicant that lacks a certificate of occupancy for the premises so long as the applicant satisfies the requirements of § 405.1. 23 DCMR 405.1 (West Supp. 2015).

However, approval of an application under § 405.1 is conditioned on the Applicant's payment of the renewal fee. 23 DCMR § 405.4 (West Supp. 2015). In this case, the Applicant failed to pay the renewal fee by March 31, 2016; therefore, the Applicant is not eligible to hold its License No. ABRA-090850 under § 405.1.

Therefore, on this 25th day of May, 2016, the Board **RESCINDS** its previous approval of ABRA License No. ABRA-090850, held by the Applicant, and the license shall be deemed **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Applicant.







Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
