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On August 18, 2016, the District of Columbia (Government) filed a Praeceptum of Dismissal seeking dismissal of the charges listed in the Notice to Show Cause Hearing filed against SBI, LLC, t/a Touchdown (Respondent), in Case No. 16-CMP-00339. *See ABRA Case File, No. 16-CMP-00339.*

The Government seeks to dismiss the charges because the Government's witness is no longer available to appear at the hearing. Specifically, the ABRA investigator is no longer employed with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA).

ABRA shall deliver copies of this Order to the Applicant and to the Respondent.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
