**ORDER GRANTING APPLICANT'S REQUEST
FOR REINSTATEMENT**

The Application filed by Naomi's Ladder, LLC , t/a Touche, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CT License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on May 4, 2015, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On May 4, 2015, the Board dismissed the Application, because the Applicant failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. See Board Order No. 2015-248.

On May 13, 2015, Jayne Price, on behalf of the Applicant, filed a request for reinstatement indicating that she failed to attend the Roll Call Hearing due to traffic. Ms. Price requested that her case be delayed until her arrival. However, Ms. Price did not arrive until after the case was called and the hearing had concluded.

Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Application, the Board finds that Ms. Price explanation for failure to attend the Roll Call Hearing constitutes good cause to reinstate the Application pursuant to 23 DCMR 1602.3.


ORDER







Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
