ORDER DENYING APPLICANT'S REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by Beg Investments, LLC, t/a Twelve Restaurant & Lounge, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CT License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on November 12, 2013, and a Protest Status Hearing on December 11, 2013, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On December 11, 2013, the Board dismissed the Application, because the Applicant failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing. *See* Board Order No. 2013-605.

On December 17, 2013, Mathew August LeFande, Esq., on behalf of the Applicant, submitted a Request for Reinstatement indicating that Bernard Gibson, the Applicant's representative, was unable to attend the Protest Status Hearing due to illness. Mr. Gibson was too ill to attend the hearing or notify the Agency of his incapacitation.

Based upon the above, the Board finds that Mr. Gibson made no effort to notify the Board or its administrative personnel of his inability to attend the Protest Status

Hearing. Nor did Mr. Gibson send a representative to attend the Protest Status Hearing in his stead. Therefore, the Board finds no good cause to reinstate the Applicant's Application, pursuant to 23 DCMR §1602.

ORDER

The Board does hereby, this 15th day of January, 2014, **DENY** the reinstatement of the Application filed by Beg Investments, LLC, t/a Twelve Restaurant & Lounge, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CT License.





Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any Party adversely affected by this Order may file a Motion for Reconsideration within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b).
