
On October 27, 2010, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("23 DCMR") § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed the Application because the Applicant failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing. The Applicant filed a timely request for reinstatement with the Board, explaining the reasons for not appearing. Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Applicant, the Board finds good cause to reinstate the Application pursuant to 23 D.C.M.R. 1602.3.


ORDER






