1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 [10:15 a.m.]

3 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: The next case on our  
4 show cause hearing status is case number 15-CMT-  
5 00355, Stoney's, license number 75613. Will the  
6 parties please approach?

7 MS. PHILLIPS: Louise Phillips, Assistant  
8 Attorney General for the District of Columbia.

9 MR. FONSECA: Michael Fonseca on behalf  
10 of the Licensee. With me is its President and  
11 Principal, Tony Harris.

12 [Pause.]

13 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Are there any  
14 preliminary matters?

15 MS. PHILLIPS: Yes, there are, sir. The  
16 parties have an offer in compromise to present to  
17 the board. It is a settlement of \$2,150 to be  
18 paid, I understand, today.

19 MR. FONSECA: That is correct.

20 MS. PHILLIPS: And if it's paid today,  
21 the license won't be suspended.

22 [Laughter.]

1           MR. FONSECA: We note then, for the  
2 record, that the Licensee was served, has read  
3 the show cause, and we waive. We further thank  
4 you.

5           CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: All right. Mr.  
6 Fonseca, it's my understanding that there is an  
7 offer in compromise for \$2,150, and that the fee,  
8 the fine will be paid today. And if it's not  
9 paid today, the license will be suspended.

10           Is that your understanding of the  
11 agreement, sir?

12           MR. HARRIS: Yes.

13           CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: And do you know that  
14 by accepting this offer in compromise, you are  
15 waiving your right to a hearing?

16           MR. HARRIS: Right, sir.

17           CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: And do you also agree  
18 that if, also by accepting this offer in  
19 compromise, that you are waiving your right to  
20 appeal this matter?

21           MR. HARRIS: Yes.

22           CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: All right. All

1 right. Do the board members have any comments  
2 regarding this offer in compromise?

3 [No audible response.]

4 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Hearing none, then I  
5 move that the license -- I'm sorry. I move that  
6 the offer in compromise, a fine of \$2,150, be  
7 accepted payable today. Is there a second?

8 MS. MILLER: Second.

9 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Ms. Miller second the  
10 motion. Those in favor, say Aye.

11 [Chorus of Ayes.]

12 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: Those opposed?

13 [No audible response.]

14 CHAIRMAN ANDERSON: The matter passed 5-  
15 0-0. All right. Ms. Walker will bring you your  
16 documents to sign, and thank you very much.
