1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right then I
3 will call -- I'll call -- I'll recall Case #14-
4 CMP-00399, Ethiopian Restaurant and Market,
5 License #91373. Will the parties please approach
6 and identify yourself for the record, please.

7 MR. RIVERO: Good morning, board members.
8 Fernando Rivero for the District of Columbia .
9 The government was advised this morning that the
10 licensee is unable to appear, apparently because
11 of the snow, and consents to a continuation of
12 the show cause hearing that is scheduled for
13 right now, at 10:00 today.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Based on the
15 weather that everyone's aware of, for the record
16 D.C. today is our second day of business based on
17 the 20 inches or so of snow that we have had over
18 the last couple of days, and I'm in favor of
19 continuing this matter, and the government
20 doesn't oppose. Do we have? --
