CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. We are back on the record to do our agendas for March 5, 2014. I'm going to start with the Legal Agenda.

No. 1 on the Legal Agenda is a Motion to Consolidate Protests, 13-PRO-00153 and 14-PRO-00005, dated February 19, 2014 from Makan Shirafkan, counsel for Park Place, Inc. The protestants consent to the motion. They did that via email dated February 25, 2014. This concerns Park at 14th located at 920 14th Street, N.W., License No. 75548.

I move that we approve this motion. Do I have a second?

MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has seconded the motion.

All those in favor say aye.

ALL: Aye.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those

1       opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
2       passes 4-0-0.

3                       No. 2 is a letter dated February  
4       20, 2014 from Britt Swann of 3287 M LLC in  
5       reference to CT Licenses in the Georgetown  
6       Moratorium Zone.

7                       This is an FYI that the Board has  
8       read and is aware of the concerns expressed  
9       therein. I don't believe any action is  
10      required on our part, at this time.

11                      No. 3 is a request to extend  
12      petition deadline dated February 19, 2014 from  
13      Chairperson Sheila Carson-Carr of ANC-7F. The  
14      licensee objects to the request for extension  
15      via email dated February 25, 2014. The  
16      establishment that this concerns is DC Eagle  
17      located at 3701 Benning Road, N.E., License  
18      No. 93984.

19                      I move that we deny as no good  
20      reason has been presented why the 45 days was  
21      insufficient.

22                      MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks  
2 has seconded the motion.

3 All those in favor say aye.

4 ALL: Aye.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
6 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
7 passes 4-0-0.

8 No. 4 is an amendment to a  
9 settlement agreement dated February 21, 2014  
10 for Public located at 1214B 18th Street, N.W.,  
11 License No. 71638.

12 I move that we approve this  
13 amendment to the settlement agreement.

14 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks  
16 has seconded the motion.

17 All those in favor say aye.

18 ALL: Aye.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
20 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
21 passes 4-0-0.

22 No. 5 is a request from E & J

1 Gallo to provide retailers with products  
2 valued at more than \$50 and less than \$500.

3 I move that we approve this  
4 request. Do I have a second?

5 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr.  
7 Silverstein has seconded the motion.

8 All those in favor say aye.

9 ALL: Aye.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
11 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
12 passes 4-0-0.

13 Okay. We have a Supplemental  
14 Legal Agenda.

15 First on that agenda is a request  
16 motion to update protest report from Kwamina  
17 Williford, counsel for 2441 Bond Street  
18 Equities, LLC, protestants. The establishment  
19 is Bandolero, 3241 M Street, N.W, License No.  
20 75631.

21 This is in relation to the Protest  
22 Hearing that has just been continued, so I

1 would recommend that we postpone considering  
2 this motion to give the applicant time to  
3 respond.

4 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.  
6 Silverstein has seconded the motion to  
7 postpone.

8 All those in favor say aye.

9 ALL: Aye.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
11 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
12 passes 4-0-0.

13 No. 2 is a motion to postpone a  
14 Protest Hearing dated March 2, 2014 and the  
15 protestants have consented to this motion. It  
16 is for NY NY Diva located at 2406-2408 18th  
17 Street, N.W., License No. 92380.

18 I move that we approve this  
19 motion.

20 MEMBER SHORT: Second.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short has  
22 seconded the motion.

1 All those in favor say aye.

2 ALL: Aye.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
4 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
5 passes 5-0-0.

6 No. 3 is a withdrawal of a protest  
7 dated February 25, 2014 from ANC-2B. The  
8 establishment is Fireplace located at 2161 P  
9 Street, N.W., License No. 14491.

10 I move that we grant this  
11 withdrawal.

12 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez  
14 has seconded the motion.

15 All those in favor say aye.

16 ALL: Aye.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
18 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
19 passes 5-0-0. And the Board will issue an  
20 Order No. 2014-083 granting this withdrawal.

21 Okay. We have a second  
22 Supplemental Legal Agenda.

1                   The first on that is a letter  
2                   supporting the termination of settlement  
3                   agreement dated February 17, 2014 from  
4                   Woodridge South Community Association and  
5                   Gateway Community Association and the  
6                   establishment is Echostage located at 2135  
7                   Queens Chapel Road, N.E., License No. 90250.

8                   And also No. 2 involves the same  
9                   establishment. It is a withdrawal of support  
10                  for termination of settlement agreement dated  
11                  March 4, 2014 from Woodridge South Community  
12                  Association and Gateway Community Association.

13                  I would suggest that both of these  
14                  are FYIs for the Board to be aware of, but no  
15                  action is required at this time.

16                  So we also have a Licensing  
17                  Agenda.

18                  First on the Licensing Agenda is  
19                  an application for an extension of license in  
20                  safekeeping since January 2013. This is for  
21                  Duchess and The Queen located at 2102 18th  
22                  Street, N.W., License No. 089545. The

1 establishment is requesting an additional six  
2 months.

3 I would move that we grant the  
4 motion for an additional six months, but that  
5 the licensee follow-up with this  
6 establishment. The license has been in  
7 safekeeping for 18 months, which is somewhat  
8 of a long time.

9 Okay. So all those in favor of  
10 extending it for six months? Oh, second?

11 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez  
13 has seconded the motion.

14 All those in favor say aye.

15 ALL: Aye.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
17 opposed? The motion passes 5-0-0.

18 No. 2 is a request for summer  
19 garden with 34 seats for Maple located at 3418  
20 11th Street, N.W., License No. 082211.

21 I move that we placard this  
22 request. Do I have a second?

1 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Any comments?

3 Okay.

4 All those in favor say aye.

5 ALL: Aye.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
7 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
8 passes 5-0-0.

9 No. 3 is a document from Stephen  
10 J. O'Brien on behalf of Public Bar to request  
11 change of hours for a summer garden. This is  
12 for Public Bar located at 1214B 18th Street,  
13 N.W., License No. 081238.

14 I move that we approve this  
15 request. Do I have a second?

16 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks  
18 has seconded the motion.

19 All those in favor say aye.

20 ALL: Aye.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
22 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion

1 passes 5-0-0.

2 No. 4 are documents from Michael  
3 Fonseca on behalf of Number Nine requesting  
4 approval to incorporate live performances,  
5 limited to piano with pianist, into the  
6 existing entertainment endorsement. This is  
7 for Number Nine, 1435 P Street, N.W., License  
8 No. 086354.

9 I move that we refer this to  
10 licensing to follow-up. I believe that the  
11 parties may need to amend their settlement  
12 agreement. So the motion is to refer to  
13 licensing. Do I have a second?

14 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks  
16 has seconded the motion.

17 All those in favor say aye.

18 ALL: Aye.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
20 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
21 passes 5-0-0.

22 No. 5 is a letter from a Retailer

1 C Tavern licensee regarding appropriateness of  
2 limitations of Georgetown Moratorium Zone  
3 Licenses. This is the Rhino Bar and  
4 Pumphouse, 3295 M Street, N.W., License No.  
5 000523.

6 I'm just checking to see if this  
7 is either the same or similar to the letter  
8 that we addressed as No. 2 in the Legal  
9 Agenda. So in any event, I would say that  
10 this also is an FYI and no further action is  
11 required by the Board, at this time.

12 No. 6 is a letter requesting  
13 approval to allow dispersing agent Stone  
14 Dozen, LLC to disperse payments to  
15 distributors and wholesalers on behalf of  
16 licensee. This is for Joe's Seafood, Prime  
17 Steak and Stone Crab located at 740 15th  
18 Street, N.W., License No. 093894.

19 I move that we approve this  
20 request. Do I have a second?

21 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks

1 has seconded the motion.

2 All those in favor say aye.

3 ALL: Aye.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
5 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
6 passes 5-0-0.

7 No. 7 is a request from Washington  
8 Wholesale Liquor Company to provide retailer  
9 with products more than \$50 and less than  
10 \$500.

11 I move that we approve this  
12 request. Do I have a second?

13 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks  
15 has seconded the motion.

16 All those in favor say aye.

17 ALL: Aye.

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
19 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
20 passes 5-0-0.

21 No. 8 is a manager's license  
22 application for Jared Richardson, ABRA-094048.

1 I move that we approve this  
2 application. Do I have a second?

3 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks  
5 has seconded the motion.

6 All those in favor say aye.

7 ALL: Aye.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
9 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
10 passes 5-0-0.

11 No. 9 is a manager's license  
12 application for Devon N. Sharp, ABRA-094380.

13 I move that we deny the  
14 application.

15 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks  
17 has seconded the motion.

18 All those in favor say aye.

19 ALL: Aye.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
21 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion to  
22 deny passes by a vote of 5-0-0.

1                   And then we have a Supplemental  
2                   Licensing Agenda.

3                   No. 1 is revised floor plans to  
4                   determine that the application meets the  
5                   Retailer B Full-Service Grocery Store  
6                   criteria. This is for Safeway located at 3830  
7                   Georgia Avenue, N.W., License No. 93822.

8                   I move that we continue this one  
9                   week.

10                   MEMBER SHORT: Second.

11                   CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Short has  
12                   seconded the motion.

13                   All those in favor say aye.

14                   ALL: Aye.

15                   CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
16                   opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
17                   passes 5-0-0.

18                   No. 2 is a letter from Stephen  
19                   O'Brien with an application for safekeeping.  
20                   It is for The District located at 2473 18th  
21                   Street, License No. 092742.

22                   In this case, the license is

1 currently suspended and I believe that the  
2 parties will need to file a full transfer of  
3 application before we consider this matter.

4 So I move that we refer this back  
5 to licensing.

6 MEMBER RODRIGUEZ: Second.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Rodriguez  
8 has seconded the motion.

9 All those in favor say aye.

10 ALL: Aye.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those  
12 opposed? All those abstaining? The motion  
13 passes 5-0-0.

14 Okay. So I think that does now  
15 conclude our agenda items. And I will just  
16 read the instructions and take the vote on our  
17 closed meetings for next week. Okay.
