CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. We're on the record with today's meeting agenda for March 27th, 2013.

The first item on the agenda is a request for an entertainment endorsement for Bistro Bohem located at 1840 6th Street, N.W., License No. 86825. The proposed hours of the live entertainment would be Sunday through Thursday 6:00 p.m. through 2:00 a.m., Friday and Saturday 6:00 p.m. to 3:00 a.m. They're currently operating Sunday through Thursday 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. and Friday and Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m.

There aren't any pending investigative matters or enforcement matters or fines or citations, no settlement agreement. It's in ANC 6B. I move that we grant the application or approve it. Do I have a second?

MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has

1 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
2 aye?

3 (Chorus of ayes.)

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
5 opposed?

6 (No audible response.)

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
8 abstaining?

9 (No audible response.)

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The vote is 5-
11 0-0.

12 No. 2 is a license class change
13 application. The Applicant wishes to change
14 from Class B to Class A. The hours that it's
15 been approved for for operation of alcoholic
16 beverage sales/service are Sunday through
17 Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

18 There aren't any investigative
19 matters pending, no pending enforcement matters,
20 no outstanding fines or citations, no conflict
21 with settlement agreements in ANC 1B. The
22 establishment is Cork Market and Tasting Room,

1 1805 14th Street, N.W., License No. 82443.

2 I move that we placard this application. Do I
3 have a second?

4 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Silverstein
6 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
7 aye?

8 (Chorus of ayes.)

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
10 opposed?

11 (No audible response.)

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
13 abstaining?

14 (No audible response.)

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The motion
16 passes 5-0-0.

17 No. 3 is a request for an
18 entertainment endorsement for Khan's located at
19 1125 H Street, N.E., License No. 84082. It has
20 approved hours of operation and alcoholic
21 beverage sales/service Sunday through Wednesday
22 11:30 a.m. to 1:00, and Thursday 11:30 a.m. to

1 2:00 a.m., and Friday and Saturday 11:30 a.m. to
2 3:00 a.m. It's proposing this live
3 entertainment for Monday through Wednesday 10:30
4 p.m. to 1:00 a.m., Thursday 10:30 a.m. to 2:00
5 a.m., Friday and Saturday 10:30 p.m. to 3:00
6 a.m.

7 There are pending investigative
8 matters in this case. There's a potential
9 conflict with the settlement agreement. And so
10 I would move that we placard this request. Do I
11 have a second?

12 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
14 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
15 aye?

16 (Chorus of ayes.)

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
18 opposed?

19 (No audible response.)

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
21 abstaining?

22 (No audible response.)

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The vote is 5-
2 0-0 to placard.

3 No. 4 on our agenda is an
4 application for license class change from Class
5 CR to Class CT. The establishment is Acre 21,
6 1400 Irving Street, N.W., License No. 86384 in
7 ANC 1A. It's hours of operation and alcoholic
8 beverage service that have been approved are
9 Sunday 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m., Monday through
10 Thursday 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m., Friday and
11 Saturday 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m.

12 No pending investigative matters and
13 there are no pending enforcement matters. And
14 this is a class change, I would move that we
15 placard. Do I have a second?

16 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
18 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
19 aye?

20 (Chorus of ayes.)

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
22 opposed?

1 (No audible response.)

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
3 abstaining?

4 (No audible response.)

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The motion
6 passes 5-0-0.

7 No. 5 is a request for off-site
8 storage of books and records at owner's
9 residence. The establishment is Paragon Thai
10 Restaurant, 3507 Connecticut Avenue, N.W.,
11 License No. 91375.

12 I move that we deny this application
13 because the residence is in Gaithersburg to
14 begin with and storage has to be in the
15 District.

16 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.
18 Silverstein has seconded the motion. Any other
19 comments?

20 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes?

22 MEMBER ALBERTI: I would just like

1 to comment that whenever we allow a licensee to
2 store originals off site outside the District,
3 we always, always require that they keep copies
4 in the District. And in this case the licensee
5 says that they have no room to keep the
6 originals, so I would have to assume that they
7 have no room to keep copies, and thus I'm voting
8 to deny this request.

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Right.
10 Any other comments?

11 (No audible response.)

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Let's
13 take a vote then. It's a motion to deny that's
14 been seconded. All those in favor of the motion
15 to deny, say aye?

16 (Chorus of ayes.)

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
18 opposed?

19 (No audible response.)

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
21 abstaining?

22 (No audible response.)

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. I think
2 there is some solution for this person and they
3 should either contact our agency or an attorney
4 to figure out what that is, but this is not the
5 solution.

6 Okay. No. 6 is a review of a
7 manager's license for Jose Ponce. I would move
8 that we approve this application. Do I have a
9 second?

10 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Silverstein
12 has seconded the motion. All those in favor,
13 say aye?

14 (Chorus of ayes.)

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
16 opposed?

17 (No audible response.)

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
19 abstaining?

20 (No audible response.)

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Motion passes
22 5-0-0.

1 No. 7 is a letter dated March 13,
2 2013 from ANC 1C requesting that the Board
3 placard all changes to licenses in Adams Morgan
4 that relate to entertainment, occupancy, or
5 hours of operation. I believe it also expresses
6 some concerns that the ANC has with some of the
7 Board's decisions in general. In any event,
8 this is an FYI letter and I suggest that there's
9 no action on the part of the Board that's
10 required, but we certainly are sharing this with
11 our director and our general counsel, and we
12 note their concerns. Okay. Anybody else want
13 to comment on that?

14 (No audible response.)

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right.
16 Eight. This is a correspondence from Alireza
17 Hajialigoli for permission to reopen business.
18 The business is or was Chloe and I guess became
19 District Lounge and Grille located at 2473 18th
20 Street, N.W., License No. 81908. This license
21 has been canceled and therefore it can't be
22 reinstated. He will have to apply for a new

1 license in my view, so therefore I would move
2 that we deny this request. Do I have a second?

3 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
5 seconded the motion. Any other comments?

6 MEMBER JONES: Point of
7 clarification.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

9 MEMBER JONES: This license has been
10 canceled?

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Correct.

12 MEMBER JONES: So it's not in
13 safekeeping?

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Let me double-
15 check. I don't believe this one is.

16 MEMBER ALBERTI: This is the one for
17 Gee's Market?

18 MEMBER BROOKS: No. No, no, this is
19 Chloe/District.

20 MEMBER ALBERTI: I don't believe the
21 license has -- no, the license hasn't been
22 canceled.

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I thought that
2 was what our staff told us.

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: No.

4 MEMBER JONES: They were referring
5 to Gee's license wasn't canceled?

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: No, Cookie --
7 no.

8 MEMBER ALBERTI: No. No. No. I
9 believe on No. 8 it's in safekeeping. What I
10 think -- what information I personally don't
11 currently have is who is the license owner of
12 the license at this address.

13 MEMBER JONES: So pause.
14 Understood. I just want to get clarification on
15 whether or not this one that we're referring to,
16 Chloe's, has actually been canceled.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Maybe we should
18 come back to it --

19 MEMBER ALBERTI: But wait.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: -- because that
21 is my recollection of what I heard staff say?

22 MEMBER ALBERTI: Chloe? No.

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: It's not
2 written in here.

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: This --

4 MEMBER JONES: Chloe. We are on
5 Chloe.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes, correct.
7 Yes, Chloe.

8 MEMBER ALBERTI: My recollection is
9 that the license that was originally owned by --
10 what was originally under the trade name of
11 Chloe --

12 MEMBER JONES: Yes.

13 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- was transferred
14 to a different party and the trade name became
15 District --

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Right.

17 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- Lounge and
18 Grille.

19 MEMBER JONES: Okay.

20 MEMBER ALBERTI: The license that
21 was under the trade name of District Lounge and
22 Grille, to my current knowledge, I believe is in

1 safekeeping.

2 MEMBER JONES: Okay.

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: But I don't --

4 MEMBER JONES: As it stands --

5 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- know if that

6 license is being transferred back to its

7 original --

8 MEMBER JONES: So there's some

9 disagreement.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Correct.

11 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- to the

12 individual who wrote this letter.

13 MEMBER JONES: So there's some

14 disagreement. I think before we go on record

15 saying it was canceled, let's figure out what it

16 is, the status, because I don't think we're on

17 the same page --

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: So I'm

19 suggesting that if we pass this and maybe --

20 MEMBER ALBERTI: I would say that

21 whether this license has been canceled or not is

22 almost irrelevant to this correspondence. I

1 think the correspondence is just asking for
2 permission to reopen business for this
3 individual, reopen business at this location.

4 My opinion is that this person is
5 free to make application for a business at this
6 location or if in fact this license is in
7 safekeeping, he's free to make application to
8 bring the license out of safekeeping and he can
9 correspond with ABRA staff to find out how
10 that's done. That's my personal opinion.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I'm fine with
12 that, because actually the request that's
13 written here is for a hearing for the Board to
14 allow me to reopen my business, to operate or
15 operate and try to resell. So regardless, I
16 would suggest that we deny the request for a
17 hearing and instruct the applicant as Mr.
18 Alberti said. He's free to file an application
19 or check with the staff how to proceed.
20 Correct?

21 MEMBER ALBERTI: I agree, and mostly
22 I agree because we don't have an application

1 before us --

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Right.

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- on which to hold
4 a hearing.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. I would
6 move then to deny the request.

7 MEMBER JONES: Just for a point of
8 clarification?

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Sure.

10 MEMBER JONES: We had an existing
11 motion on the floor that had been properly
12 seconded.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Then I will
14 withdraw my motion. Thank you.

15 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Motion to
16 withdraw. Second.

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So I
18 move that we deny then the request for the
19 hearing that is written in the letter for No. 8.
20 Do I have a second?

21 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Second.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Silverstein

1 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
2 aye?

3 (Chorus of ayes.)

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
5 opposed?

6 (No audible response.)

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
8 abstaining?

9 (No audible response.)

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Then the
11 vote is 5-0-0 to deny the request.

12 All right. No. 9 is a letter dated
13 March 13, 2013 from ANC 1A requesting that the
14 Board revoke Gee's Market's liquor license.
15 Gee's Market is located at 3583 Warder Street,
16 N.W., License No. 83125.

17 I move that we deny this request;
18 and I understand that they're pending litigation
19 with respect to DCRA on this one, and we not
20 take any action until that's resolved. Anyway,
21 I would deny it for that reason.

22 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Madam Chair?

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes.

2 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: I would ask
3 that we delay any action pending the outcome of
4 litigation involving another agency.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Any
6 comments by Board Members?

7 MEMBER ALBERTI: I would say that
8 any action that we consider with regards to this
9 license is apart from this request from the ANC.
10 There is no legal basis for us to act on such a
11 request from an ANC. We are looking at the
12 status of this license for other reasons apart
13 from the request from the ANC. If their effort
14 with this letter is to draw our attention to
15 other matters, I would note that we are aware of
16 all of the matters surrounding this license and
17 I would just treat this as for our information,
18 this letter as being just for our information.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Others?

20 (No audible response.)

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: I think it's
22 requesting that we, you know, take action with

1 respect to revocation, so I would tend to either
2 deny or postpone action.

3 MEMBER ALBERTI: And we're denying
4 on the basis of why?

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: We're not
6 taking action now.

7 MEMBER ALBERTI: Based on what basis
8 are we denying their request?

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: On the basis
10 that we're waiting for resolution of DCRA's
11 adjudication.

12 MEMBER ALBERTI: Again I would point
13 out the only --

14 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: When they have
15 good standing.

16 MEMBER ALBERTI: -- basis on which
17 we could deny their request is that we can't
18 legally take action based on their request.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. I'll go
20 with the quick one then. You want to read your
21 motion, I mean your motion? It hasn't been
22 seconded yet. So, Mr. Silverstein?

1 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: As we
2 discussed, I move that we deny the request and
3 inform them that we have postponed any
4 consideration or action on this matter because
5 of pending litigation involving another agency.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. I second
7 the motion.

8 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Go off the
9 record for a second?

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

11 (Whereupon, at 4:06 p.m. off the
12 record until 4:06 p.m.)

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. The
14 motion has been seconded. All those in favor,
15 say aye?

16 MEMBER ALBERTI: Could you repeat
17 the motion, please?

18 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Mr.
19 Silverstein?

20 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: The motion is
21 that we deny the request and inform them that we
22 are delaying any action in this case pending

1 resolution of litigation involving another D.C.
2 agency and this licensee.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. That's
4 been seconded. Any other comments? All right.

5 MEMBER ALBERTI: I'm going to oppose
6 this motion because, as I again stated earlier,
7 we could never take action against this licensee
8 based simply on a request from an ANC to revoke
9 a license. We have no legal basis to do that
10 based on such a request. So denying it is kind
11 of superfluous. We're denying something that we
12 could never do and denying it we're acting as if
13 in theory we could act on it, we could in theory
14 approve it. But we couldn't. So it doesn't
15 make any sense to deny this. I think we just
16 treat this as an FYI. And as I said, inform
17 them if we wish to that we are aware of all the
18 issues surrounding this licensee.

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

20 MEMBER ALBERTI: So I will vote
21 against this.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Anybody

1 else?

2 (No audible response.)

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Well,
4 the motion has been seconded. All those in
5 favor, say aye? Aye.

6 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Aye.

7 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
8 opposed?

9 MEMBER ALBERTI: Opposed.

10 MEMBER JONES: Opposed.

11 MEMBER BROOKS: Opposed.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
13 abstaining?

14 (No audible response.)

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: So the vote is
16 2-3-0 and the motion fails. Do we have a
17 different motion for resolving this letter?

18 MEMBER ALBERTI: I move that we
19 treat this as an FYI.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

21 MEMBER ALBERTI: And suggest that
22 the licensee speak to our legal counsel who can

1 inform them that the Board is aware of all of
2 the issues surrounding this license.

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. We just
4 leave it as an FYI?

5 MEMBER ALBERTI: Yes.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All right.
7 I'll second the motion. We have a motion that
8 we treat this as an FYI and I've seconded it.
9 All those in favor, say aye?

10 (Chorus of ayes.)

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
12 opposed?

13 (No audible response.)

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Those
15 abstaining?

16 (No audible response.)

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Motion passes
18 5-0-0.

19 Okay. No. 10 is a settlement
20 agreement dated March 11, 2013 between Le
21 Liquors and ANC 1C. Le Liquors is located at
22 1776 Columbia Road, N.W., License No. 90659.

1 I believe that the settlement
2 agreement looked fine, but it was -- wait just
3 one second -- not accompanied by a cover letter
4 indicating that the ANC had properly noticed
5 consideration of a settlement agreement, it had
6 a quorum, etcetera, in voting on this. So I
7 move that we postpone consideration of this
8 settlement agreement until we get that
9 authorization from the ANC. Do I have a second?

10 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
12 seconded the motion. Any other comments?

13 (No audible response.)

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. All
15 those in favor, say aye?

16 (Chorus of ayes.)

17 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
18 opposed?

19 (No audible response.)

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
21 abstaining?

22 (No audible response.)

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Motion passes
2 5-0-0.

3 No. 11 is a settlement agreement
4 amendment dated March 18th, 2013 between Hank's
5 Oyster Bar and ANC 6B. Hank's Oyster Bar is
6 located at 633 Pennsylvania Avenue, S.E.,
7 License No. 89718.

8 I move that we approve this
9 settlement agreement amendment. Do I have a
10 second?

11 MEMBER BROOKS: Second.

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Mr. Brooks has
13 seconded the motion. All those in favor, say
14 aye?

15 (Chorus of ayes.)

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
17 opposed?

18 (No audible response.)

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
20 abstaining?

21 (No audible response.)

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Motion passes

1 5-0-0.

2 No. 12 is a settlement agreement
3 amendment dated March 11th, 2013 between
4 Ziegfield's/Secrets and ANC 6D.
5 Ziegfield's/Secrets is located at 1824 Half
6 Street, S.W., License No. 78663.

7 I believe this settlement agreement
8 amendment also looks fine except it's not
9 accompanied by a letter from the ANC again
10 indicating that proper notice was given and that
11 there was a quorum present, etcetera. So I
12 would move that we postpone this one also until
13 we get that kind of authorization from the ANC.
14 Do I have a second?

15 MEMBER ALBERTI: Second.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. All
17 those in favor, say aye?

18 (Chorus of ayes.)

19 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those
20 opposed?

21 (No audible response.)

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: All those

1 abstaining?

2 (No audible response.)

3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The motion
4 passes 5-0-0.
