3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: The second
4 case is a Protest (Status) Hearing, Case No.
5 12-PRO-00013, Walgreens #11408, located at
6 4225 Connecticut Avenue, N.W., License No.
7 88579 in ANC-3F.

8 And good morning.

9 MR. O'BRIEN: Good morning.
10 Stephen O'Brien for the applicant.

11 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

12 MS. PERRY: Karen Perry, ANC-3F.

13 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Good
14 morning.

15 MR. O'BRIEN: Madam Chair?

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes?

17 MR. O'BRIEN: I would like to
18 report that mediation was conducted. Ms.
19 Perry and I continue to talk, but we do not
20 have a settlement of this matter, so we need
21 to continue with the scheduled Protest
22 Hearing.

1 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. Ms.
2 Perry, do you have anything you want to say
3 this morning?

4 MS. PERRY: Same thing.

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. You
6 agree with Mr. O'Brien?

7 MS. PERRY: I do.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. In
9 which case, the hearing is scheduled for May
10 23, 2012 at 1:30 p.m.

11 And I'm just going to give you
12 some direction ahead of time before that
13 hearing, so that you come prepared in the
14 manner that the Board would like, in case
15 you're not familiar with that.

16 You should have received in a
17 mailing from Adjudication Assistant, Sarah
18 Fashbaugh, a letter explaining the protest
19 process and a copy of the Protest Information
20 Form, sometimes referred to as the PIF.

21 If you do not have these
22 documents, please, see Ms. Fashbaugh at the

1 conclusion of this hearing.

2 It is important that you review
3 the rules closely and adhere to them before
4 and during the Protest Hearing. You are
5 required to complete and submit the Protest
6 Information Form seven days before the date of
7 the hearing. The document needs to be
8 submitted to ABRA and to the opposing parties
9 in the matter.

10 If we do not receive a copy of
11 your PIF, your application or your protest,
12 whichever side you are representing, may be
13 subject to dismissal. This form is very
14 important. It assists the Board in narrowing
15 the protest issues and focusing on issues in
16 the case and facilitating the process and
17 keeping the parties on point during the
18 hearing.
